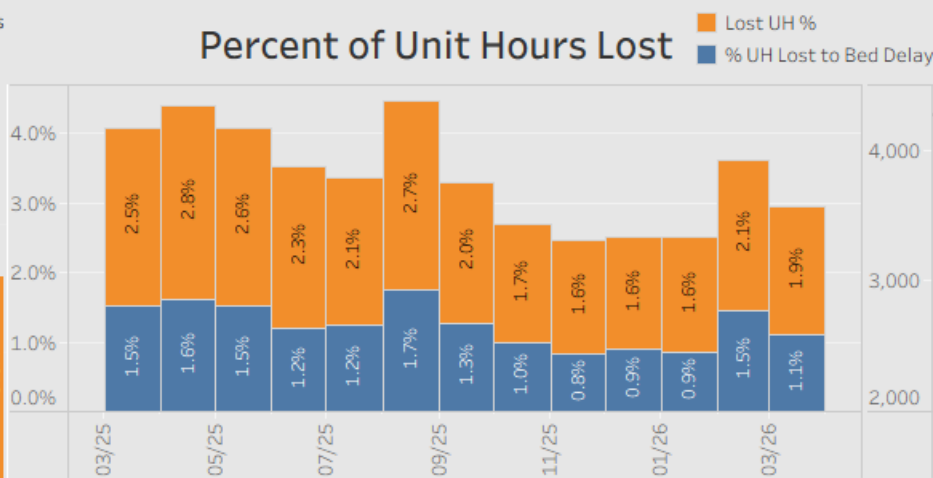

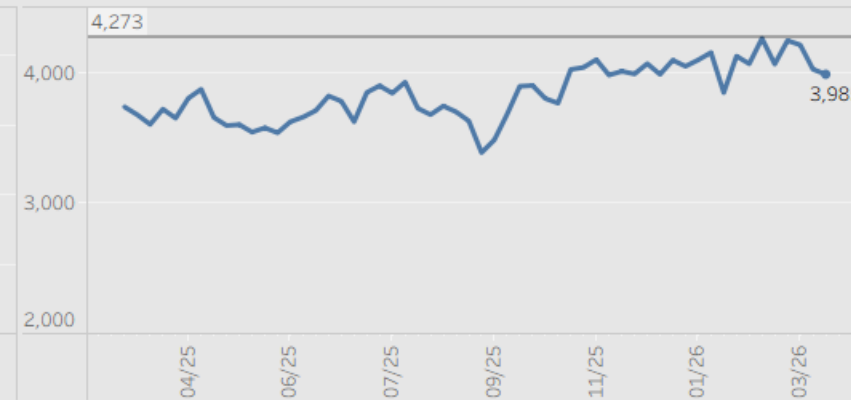

Percent of Unit Hours Lost



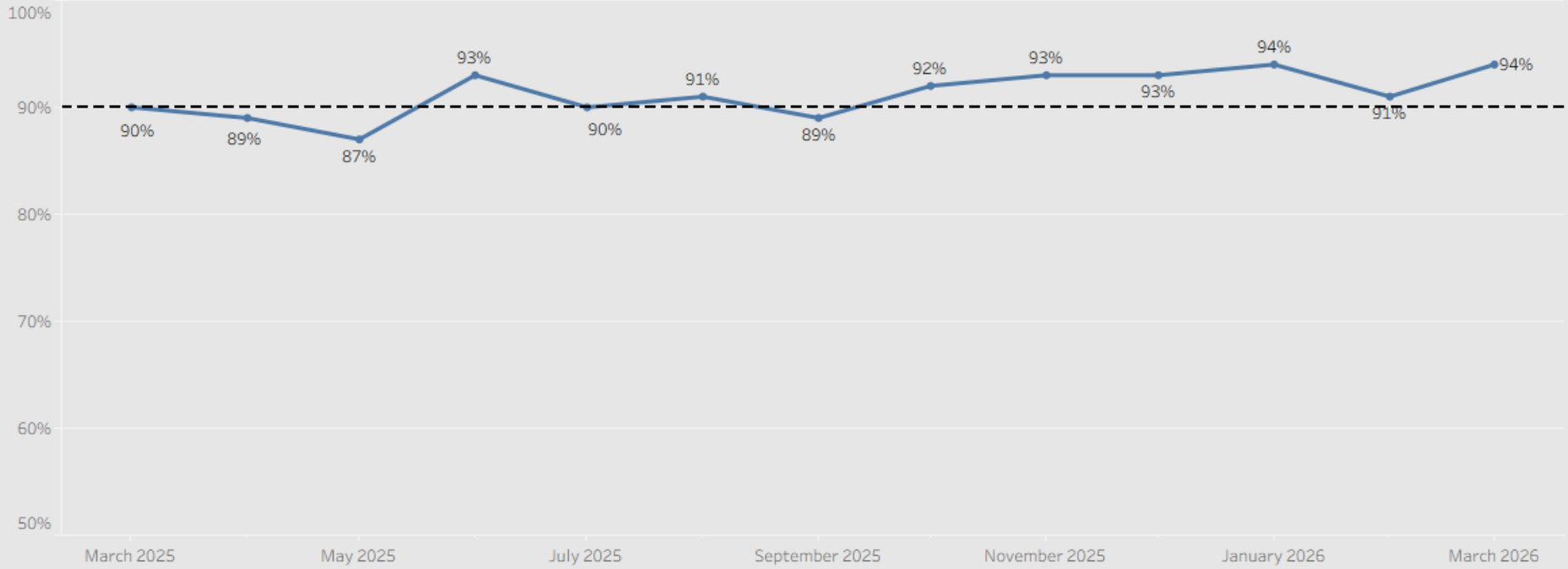
Weekly Unit Hours Produced

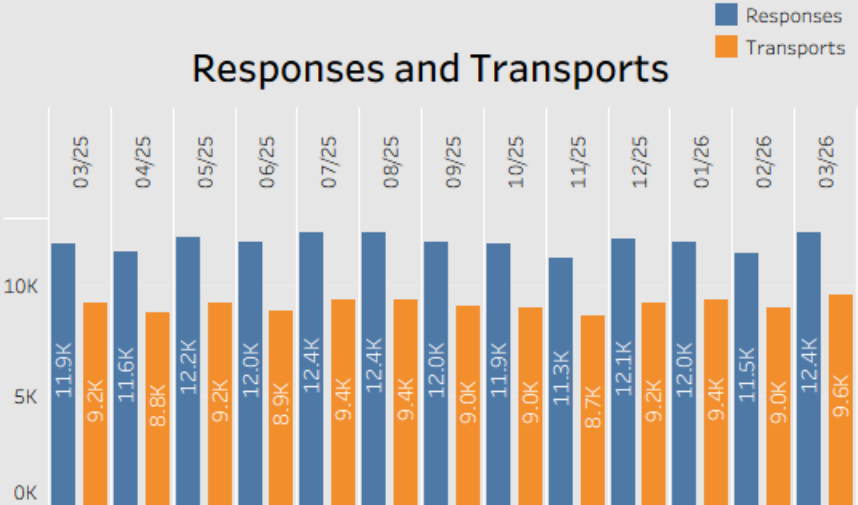
Priority One Response Time Compliance Western Division System

March 2026

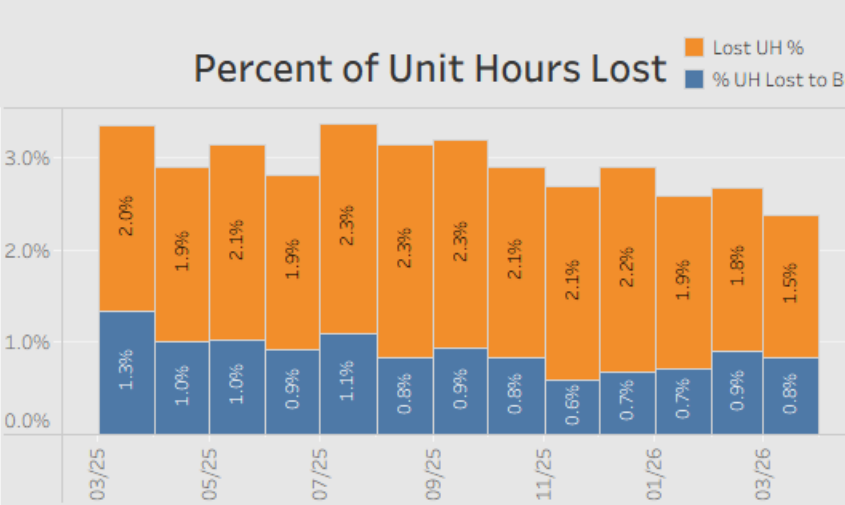

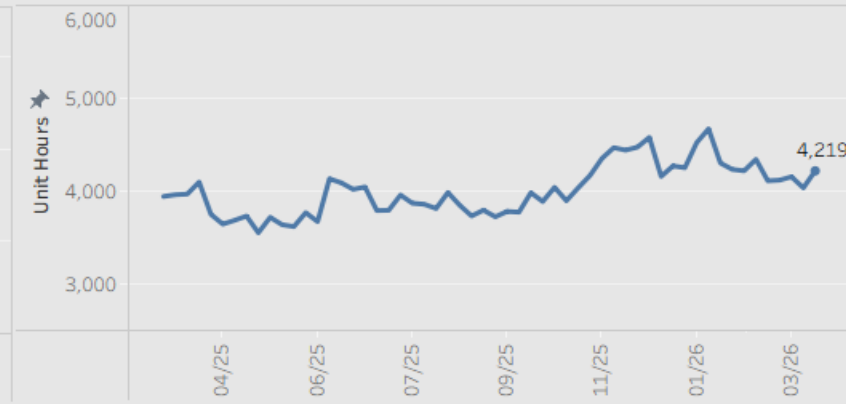
Responses and Transports



Percent of Unit Hours Lost



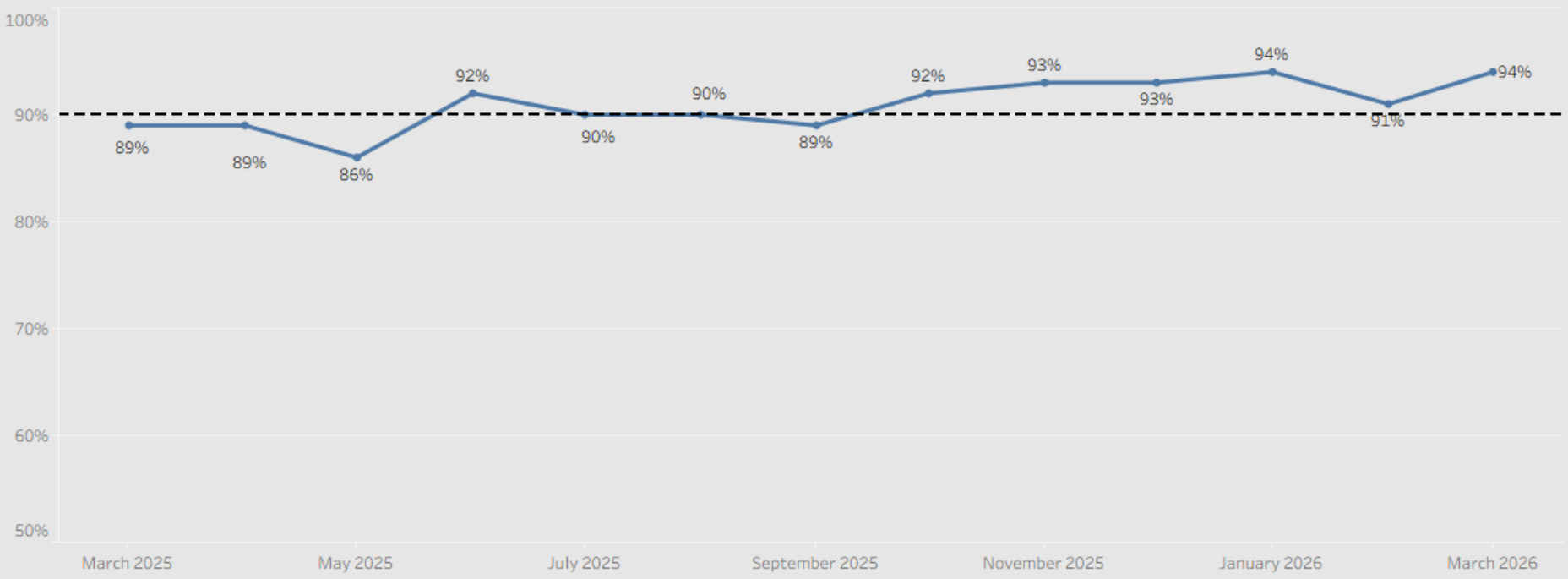
Weekly Unit Hours Produced

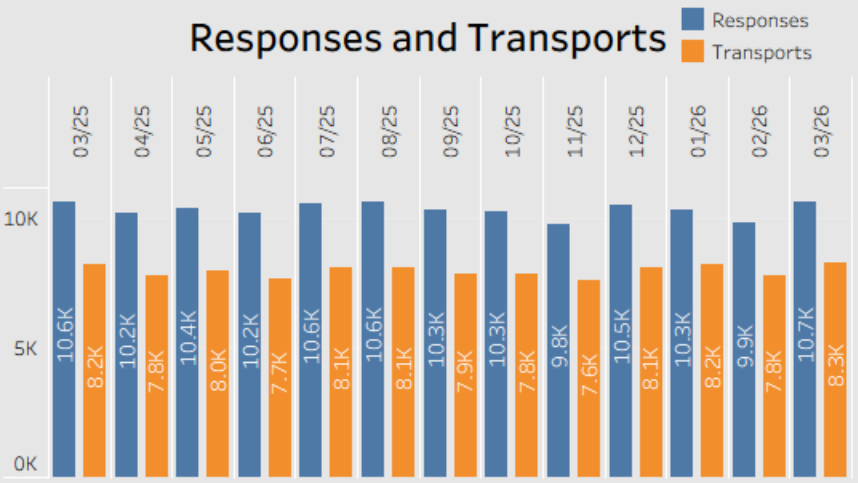
Priority One Response Time Compliance Western Division EMSA

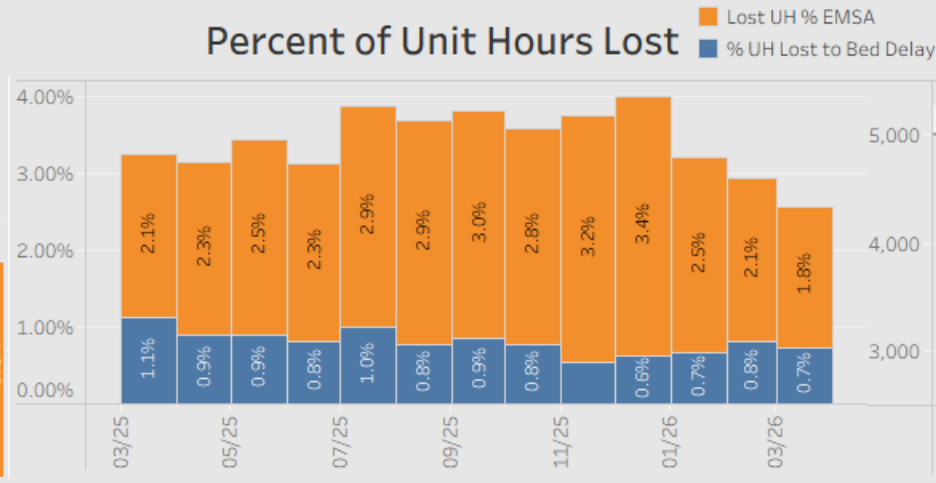

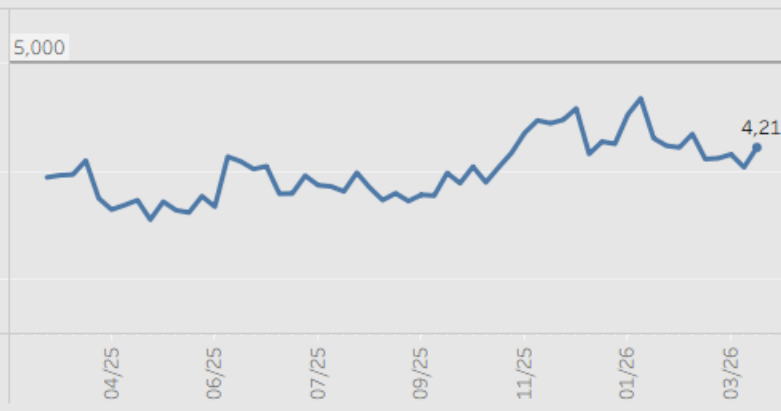
Responses and Transports

Weekly Unit Hours Produced

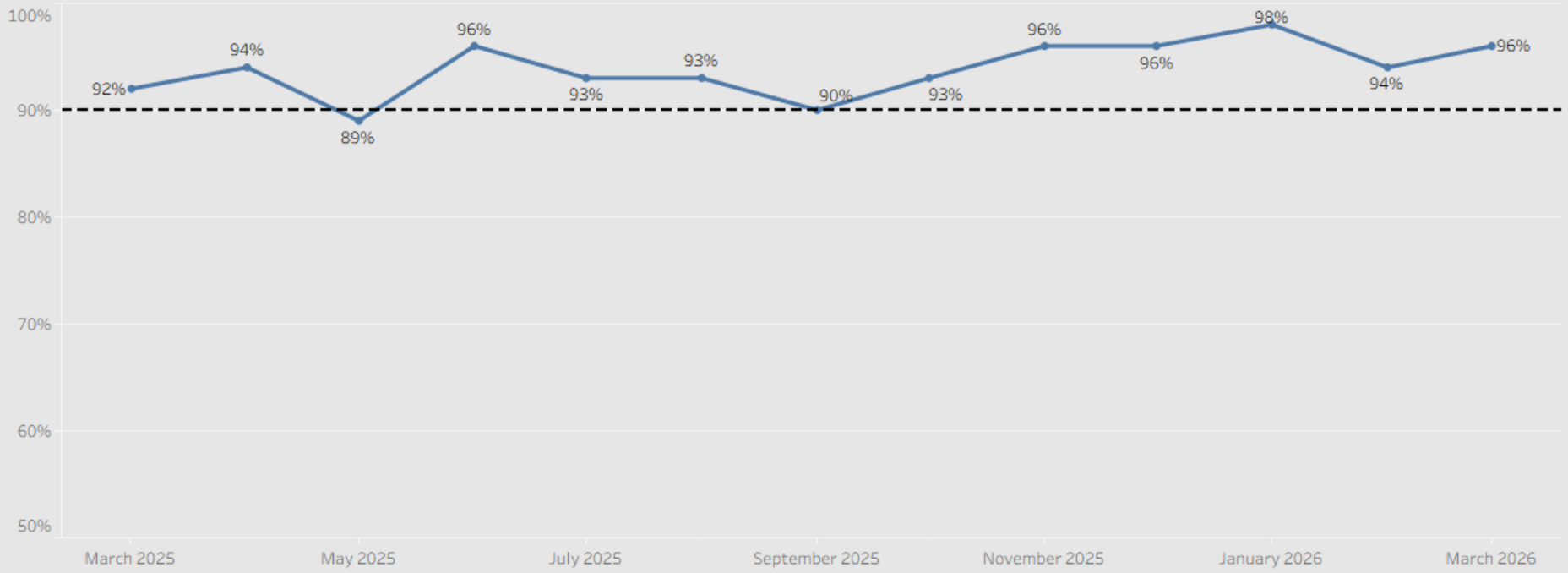

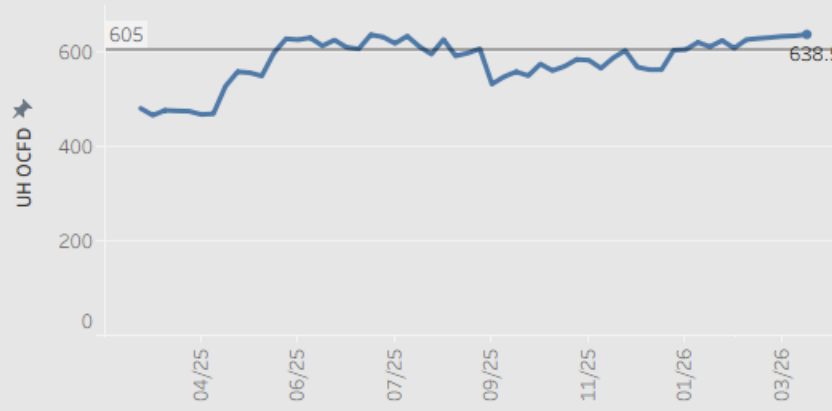
